## Suitable for

# Suggested activities

- Discuss what you can do when you leave school e.g. Modern Apprenticeships, college, university, employment
- Prepare for visits/world of work day by discussing the purpose and by becoming familiar with appropriate questionnaire. Additional questions should be added as required
- · Discuss specific Health and Safety requirements
- Young people to complete relevant questionnaire with employers, training providers, colleges, universities. Online resources can also be used to gather information where visits do not take place

- Knowledge gained to be shared by reporting back orally or through written reports using diagrams, photographs etc
