

Lesson 4: Future Me (45-120mins)

| Activity | Teaching Notes | Resources |
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| Introduce the Session | Download and set up the PowerPoint. Remind the pupils of the previous lessons and thinking about the skills and strengths that they have. Using Slide 2 let the pupils know that today you will be thinking about what the pupils want to do in the future. | PowerPoint |
| Future Me Poster | <p>Ask the pupils to imagine it is the year 2040 and that they have now left school and are doing their dream job. Ask them to think about the job that they are doing? What do they like about their job? Did they go to university or college? What skills and qualities do they have that make them good at their job? Tell the pupils that they will be designing a poster showing this information.</p> <p>If you have access to IT/internet you can ask the pupils to research their dream job on My World of Work. This should help them answer all the questions listed above.</p> <p>If a pupil is unsure of what they want to do ask them to complete the 'Animal Me' activity on My World of Work and pick one of the jobs suggested for them based on their answers.</p> <p>These posters can be displayed in the classroom as an 'Aspirations Wall.'
