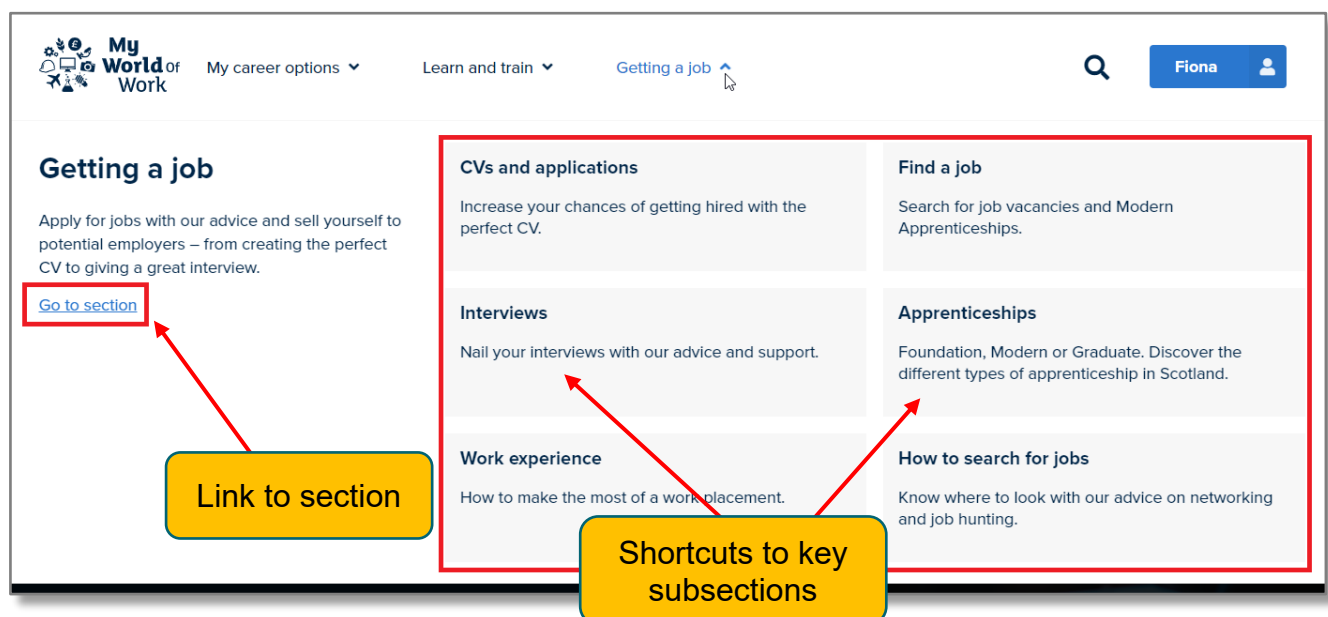
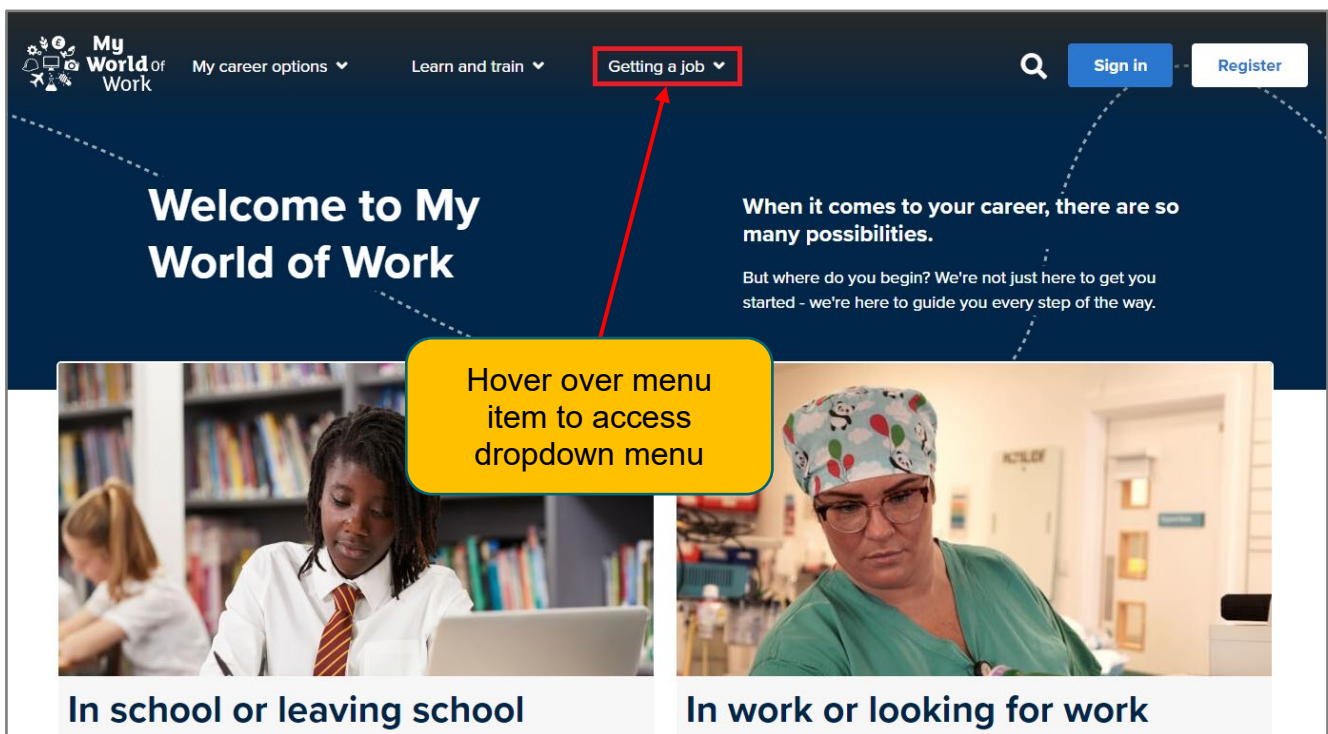


Getting a Job

From the Home page, hover over “Getting a job”, then click on “go to section” in the pop-up menu:



How to guides

This takes you straight to the Getting a job search tool, which allows you to search for current vacancies and Modern Apprenticeships across Scotland.

You can type in a location and a search radius to narrow or expand the results; there are other options when the results appear e.g. full time, part time etc available in the form of tick boxes.

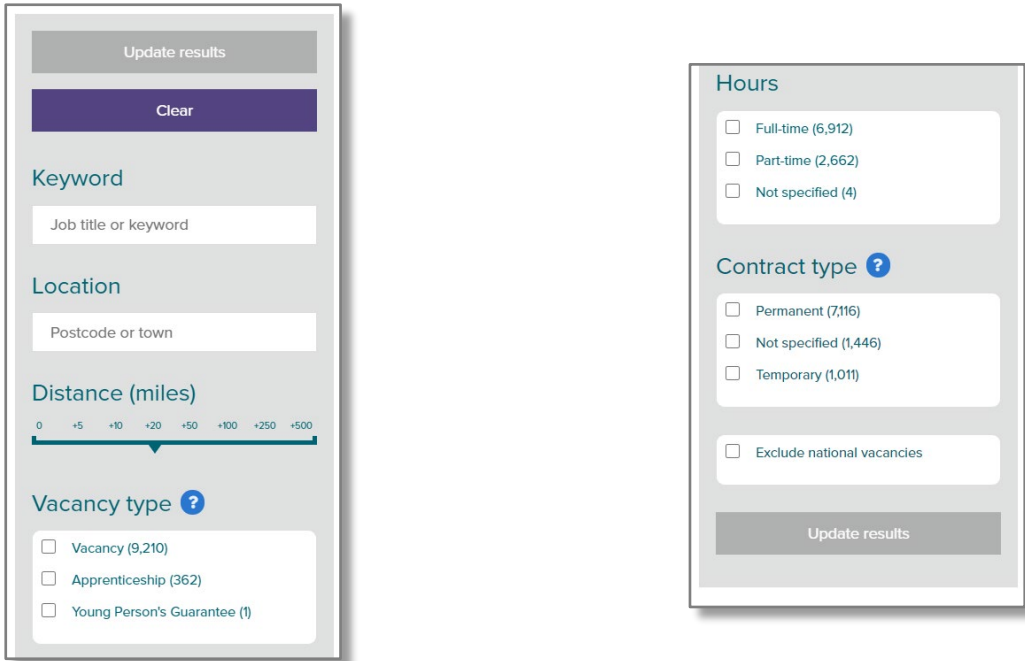
