

# Lesson insert

## Overview

An activity using [myworldofwork.co.uk](http://myworldofwork.co.uk) to link the study of Gaelic to possible careers.

## Objectives

As part of a wider lesson, this lesson insert intends to:

- Encourage pupils to think about careers related to the study of Gaelic
- Generate discussion on the dos and don'ts for Gaelic CVs and bilingual interviews

## My World of Work activity (20mins)

- Arrange pupils into four groups
- Go to [myworldofwork.co.uk](http://myworldofwork.co.uk)
- Show the videos from the real people stories listed (10mins)
- Ask two groups to read the article '[Is a Gaelic CV a good idea](#)' and then create a list of dos and don'ts
- Ask the other two groups to read the article '[How to handle a bilingual interview](#)' and then create a list of dos and don'ts

## Connect the learning (in the wider lesson)

- Start with a group looking at the article on the Gaelic CV and ask them to feedback the dos of using one
- Ask the next group to feedback the don'ts of using a Gaelic CV
- Ask the next group to feedback the dos for a bilingual interview
- Ask the next group to feedback the don'ts for a bilingual interview
- Optional: print out a copy of these articles and ask the pupils to translate them into English

## Review and reflect (5mins)

- Ask pupils to reflect on the jobs covered and if they may be interested in finding out more about these careers
- Ask pupils what other careers they have considered where having a knowledge of Gaelic would be useful
